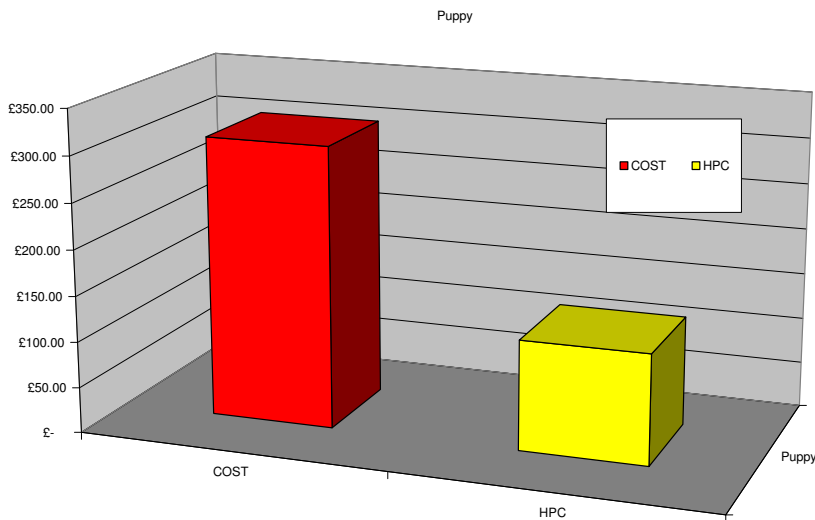
Hopefully this document will give you some idea of how this works, what it costs and what the benefit is to you.

Whilst this doesn't replace the need for pet insurance it does compliment it.

What do I get?

Healthy Pet Club members are entitled to receive the following;

Initial Two Stage Vaccinations (includes Kennel Cough)
Flea Treatments for the year (in one month blocks)
Worming treatments for a year (in one month blocks)
A Three, Six and Nine month health check
A Microchip for your pet

A Hills Diet loyalty card – Buy 5 bags of 3.5 kilos plus and get the 6th FREE
20% Discount on all Adaptil products
20% Discount on the cost of Neutering your pet
10% off all products and services offered at the practice

Should your puppy require any of the following lifetime care products;

Atopica, Rimadyl, Cosequin, Optimune, Fortekor, Vetmedin, Vivitonnin, Cannisulin, Incurin, Vidalta, Metacam, Propalin, Protexin or Soloxine

You will qualify for a 20% discount for these items all the time your pet is a member of the Healthy Pet Club.

What will it cost me?

It costs just £ 9.99 a month.

After twelve months your pet will be transferred to the Healthy Pet Club based on their estimated adult size continuing to benefit from the preventative health care and savings the scheme offers.

Have more than one pet? We can offer a £ 1.00 per month deduction for each pet after the first (not cumulative.)

Whats the catch?

No catch – the day you join the club we would ask for payment of the first month's membership fee and we will supply you with your flea and worming treatments for the next three months. Also, any fees charged that day will qualify for the full 10% discount.

How long am I tied in for?

All we ask for is two months notice to cancel your membership should you wish to – this is mainly to cover the cost of supplying treatments in three month blocks.

Should you cancel the membership within six months the cost of vaccinations and micro-chipping will be added to your account for settlement.

We hope you can see the potentially enormous benefit available to your pet and yourself inherent in the Healthy Pet Club.
